



COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION IN IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION

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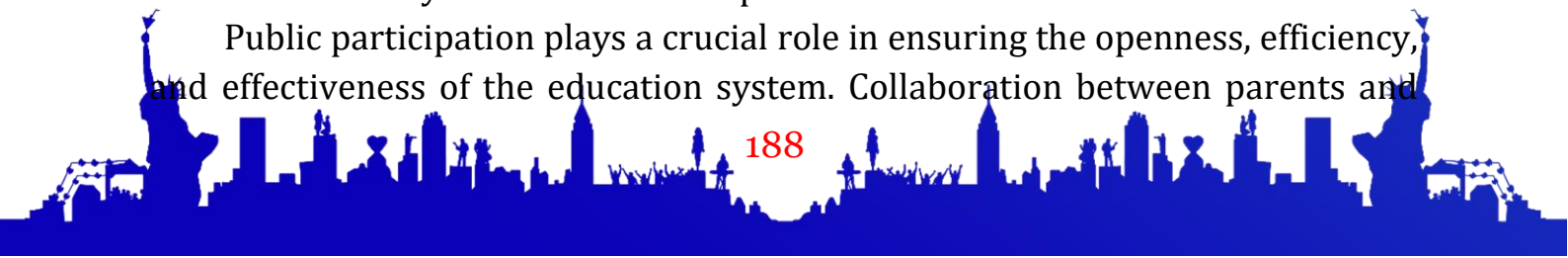

Public participation plays a crucial role in ensuring the openness, efficiency, and effectiveness of the education system. Collaboration between parents and



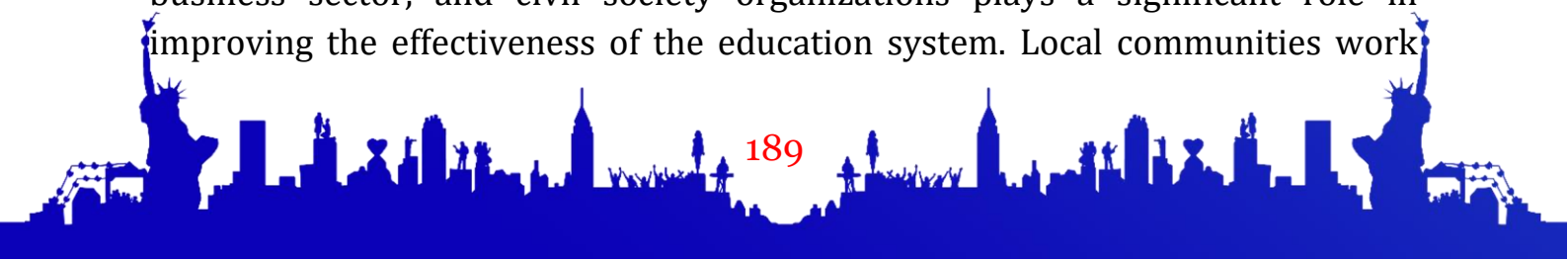

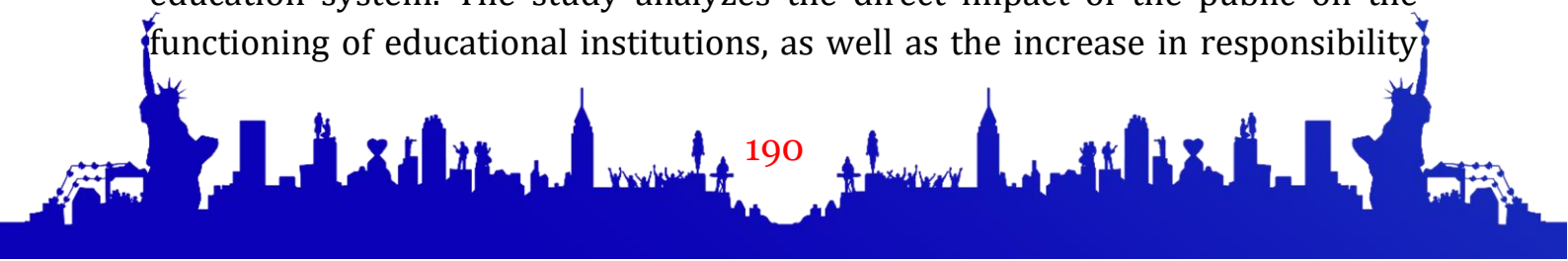

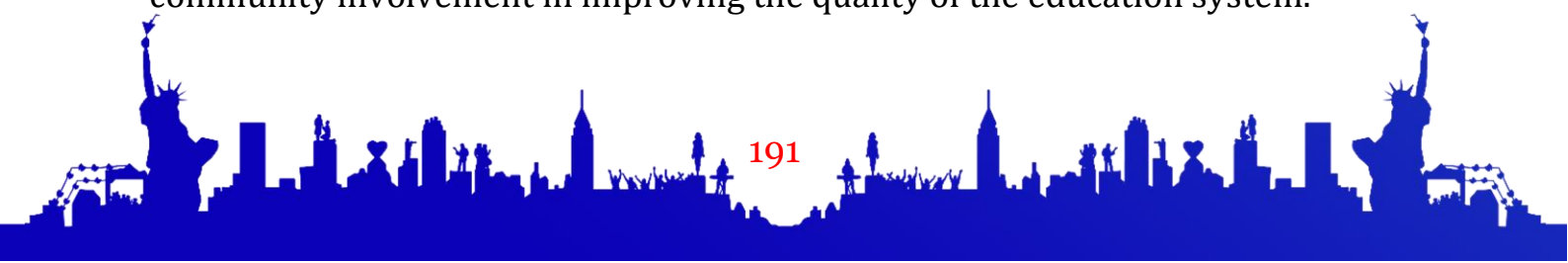

Public participation is an essential part of improving the quality of education, and its proper organization and support can significantly enhance the quality of the education system. This creates more effective opportunities for

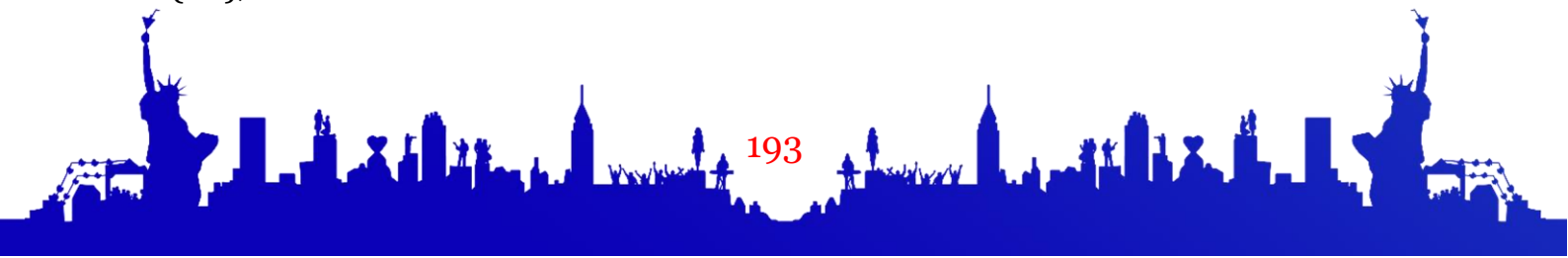




students to learn, increases society's trust in the education system, and contributes to overall social development.

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
