These responsibilities require the teacher to be a master of his or her profession, to be a professional who has an educational impact on students and seeks ways to comprehensively develop their interests, abilities, talents, beliefs, and practical skills. To do this, it is necessary to constantly improve the professional skills, abilities and qualifications of teachers, to take care of them, to create the necessary conditions, to provide the necessary material and scientificmethodological and technical assistance, to help teachers to increase their creative initiative.

The subject "Pedagogical skills" serves to train skilled teachers, teaches the secrets of professional activity of teachers and educators, provides information on their improvement and the essence of pedagogical skills, ways, means and forms of professional development in accordance with modern requirements.

On this basis, we can highlight the personal characteristics of a teacher, which contributes to the productivity of professional skills in pedagogical activity: pedagogical pedagogical delicacy, pedagogical technique, mastery of public speaking, high pedagogical and psychological knowledge, deep knowledge of their subject, thinking. wealth, political literacy, breadth of thinking, politeness, courtesy, attentiveness, team spirit, adaptability

It should be noted that the list of personal characteristics and personal qualities of a teacher with experience and pedagogical skills can be further expanded.

Authors who have conducted research in this area, in particular L.M. Mitina, have included in the group of certain pedagogical abilities such personal qualities and characteristics of the teacher as pedagogical goal setting, pedagogical thinking, pedagogical reflection, pedagogical etiquette and moral norms listed above [131: 19p.]. The setting of pedagogical goals as one of the important features of pedagogical skills is also analyzed in the works of VI Zagyvazinsky [57], and AK Markova [125: 140 p.]. VI Zagvyazinsky describes the setting of pedagogical goals in the work of teachers as the selection of the most optimal teaching options and correlates the level of environment, knowledge and skills with "students' cognitive activity in the immediate area of development" [125: p. 91]. According to AK Markova, "pedagogical goal setting is the teacher's need to plan their work on a scientific basis, and at the same time to make suggestions for the teacher to produce based on society and his personal goals, and then present them to students for discussion." is the ability to [125:20 p.]. It should be noted that there are many differences in the definition of "pedagogical skills". The diversity of the definitions given is due to the fact that the authors consider a clear description of pedagogical skills through different scientific and contemporary positions.

Pedagogical skill is a systematic teacher's

character, characterized by the unity of intellectual, volitional, emotional and physical aspects of the process of self-government, which is reflected in the "live" pedagogical activity of the teacher, formed and improved, helps to achieve a high level of professionalism.

Pedagogical skills - a feature that determines the personal (childhood, kindness, humanity. kindness, etc.) and professional (knowledge, intelligence, dedication, creativity, ability, etc.) qualities of teachers, the high level of professionalism of teachers, is an activity that provides the opportunity to continuously improve their skills. It is reflected in the professional activity of every teacher who knows subject perfectly, has pedagogicaland methodological training, psychological conducts practical activities to find optimal ways of teaching, educating and developing students.

As a result of scientific research, which connects the regular live pedagogical activity with the requirements of modern times, the phenomenon of "pedagogical skills" is enriched with different ideas and considerations. The concept of "pedagogical skill" observed in pedagogical activity is not considered as an object consisting of individual features, but as an indivisible whole concept, that is, a network of relations that introduces the teacher to the mandatory pedagogical space. In this way, it is possible to understand that there is not enough information to describe the essence of "pedagogical skills", its basic concepts, content, all methods of perception from a modern point of view.

The teacher is a person who ensures the quality of training highly qualified personnel, and his moral image is formed at the level of modern requirements, in accordance with standards and constantly evolving.


