Only then, your chances of remembering the language will rise dramatically. Linguists have divided learning foreign languages into four categories:

1. Reading is the ability to understand a text while reading it in a foreign language.

2. Listening is the comprehension of a text while listening in a foreign language.

3. Writing-Ability to write in a foreign language.

4. Speaking is the ability to express oneself in a foreign language. Here are three key pointers in moving forward:

- grammar;
- richness of dictionary;
- pronunciation.

Thus, it is quite difficult to learn foreign languages without mastering these three things.

Grammar. Many students who are learning foreign languages are often stubborn when it comes to grammar. Whether we like it or not, the most difficult part of learning a language is grammar. Because of this, it is too important to learn grammar.

Richness of dictionary. One of well-known American scientist – Tim Ferriss can easily speak in seven foreign languages. He explains the secret of language learning as follows: It takes 3 months to understand 90% of any foreign language, but it takes 3 years to understand 95%. So, it takes a lot of work to be master a language. While utilizing dictionary, it is enough to memorize the most commonly used words in the language. Then all you have to do is learn the words in the field you need. When speaking a foreign language, in 90% of cases, only about 1,000 common words are used, and the rest is enough for everyone to learn according to their domain.

Pronunciation. Each language has its own pronunciation. Linguists estimate that there are more than 150 sounds in all, and that each language typically uses an average of 30 sounds. As a result, there is a huge difference in the pronunciation of languages. For example, there are no English nasal sounds in our language. Usually, the easiest way to develop your pronunciation after learning a language is to listen to the foreign language as much as possible. The importance of repetition in learning a foreign language should also be kept in mind. Repetition is the mother of knowledge. Repeating the grammar topic you learned every week will help to strengthen it and keep it in your memory even better.

Conclusion. It is known that the study and teaching of foreign languages has become a modern necessity in our country – Uzbekistan as well as other developed countries. It is no exaggeration to say that the opportunities which are created for youngsters in order to learn foreign languages, are proving their positive results. Not only the example of foreign languages, but also significant changes and innovations are taking place in all spheres of science.

Taking advantage of these opportunities, we must study hard and educate well. Anyone who wants to learn foreign languages perfectly can learn it on their own.
